The Persecuted Church

Daily Prayer:

Sun 11: Open Doors– persecuted Christians. The persecution of Christians has increased across every region in which Open Doors works. Religious extremism – Islamic, Hindu and Buddhist – is the greatest source of persecution of Christians.

Mon 12: Syria. Remember the almost 6 million refugees who have fled war, that churches in their host countries will show them the love of Christ.

Tue 13: Iraq. A few Christians live secretly in I.S. held areas - pray for their safety.

Weds 14: United International Café. Pray for the team as they talk week by week with students studying here and give them a bible as they leave.

Thurs 15: Worldwide. Remember those held in captivity for their faith.

Fri 16: Government. Pray that 'Freedom of Religion or Belief' will be mainstreamed within the work of the Foreign and
